How did you first hear about Ner Tamid?

O.N.: I am first generation American and was fortunate to travel to the former Soviet Union when I was 12 years old and meet my dad's side of the family for the first time.

M.N.: I was born in Iran and escaped there when I was 17, was smuggled out of Iran through Pakistan and stayed in Vienna for 6 months before I arrived in US. I love to travel & see the world.

O.N.: I have been heavily involved in the past among various initiatives. I love meeting new people and therefore outreach-getting more people to know and fall in love with Ner Tamid.
