I went to Kibbutz Sdei Eliyahu for a few months where I vigorously studied the language and Israeli culture, which was not easy at all. Soon after I made Aliyah and joined Garin Tzabar, a pre-army program for lone soldiers. I was put on Kibbutz Ein Tzurim with 20 other future lone soldiers, given an amazing adoptive family and got ready for the army. I drafted to Michve Alon in December 2016. Michve Alon is an intensive Hebrew course in the army. I was there for 3 months and was given the chance to try out for Special Forces. In March, I drafted into one of the Special Forces unit and unfortunately I can't tell you anything more than that. My unit is about to finish our year and two month long specialized training and we are looking to collect donations for new equipment. The new equipment will help us train better and move faster. 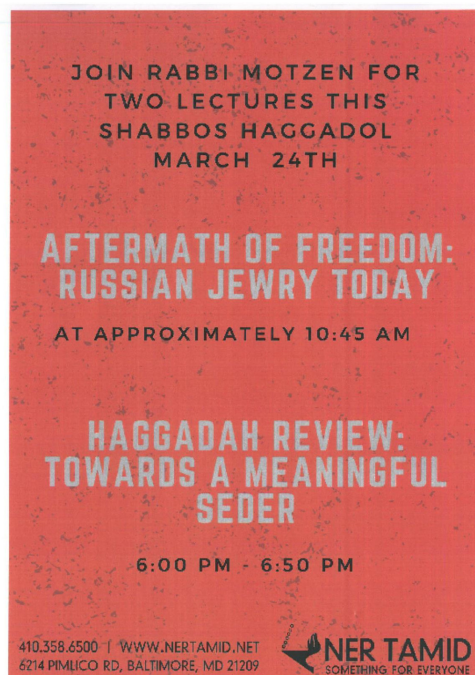

## Meet the Caplan Family!

### What brought you to Ner Tamid?

My father passed away in 1966 and Rabbi Leibowitz officiated at the funeral. My relationship with the Rabbi goes back to the beginning of the Rabbi's career at the Quantico Avenue Shul.

We were then asked to be co-chairmen of a Chanukah Dance. That was the start of a spiritual and social life. The Sisterhood had luncheons and Brotherhood dinners were fun. There were musical shows where Bev. made costumes for, Purim breakfasts, Passover candy sales...We were very involved in all the various events at NT. Our years at NT have been very rewarding for our family. Our children Sherry and Bob got a great Hebrew Education. The Hebrew School was in a class of its own and considered to be the finest in Baltimore.

Over the years, we were honored to have leadership roles in helping the forward movement of NT. Sheldon was Chairman of the Board for 3 years. In turn, we were both honored by NT as Man of the Year, and Bev. as Woman of the Year and we were both honored as NT Israel Bond's Prestegist Lion of Judah Award. Sheldon was also president of the Brotherhood, Treasurer of the Synagogue, Head of the Kitchen crew, and Chair of the Blood Drive Program. Bev. was very active in the Sisterhood. The list goes on and on...

### What is your religious background?

We were both raised Modern Orthodox, Bev. at Beth Tfiloh and I at Quantico Avenue Shul. Having been both born in Baltimore, these were neighborhood Synagogues for us.

### Anything unusual you could tell us about yourselves? What are your hobbies?
