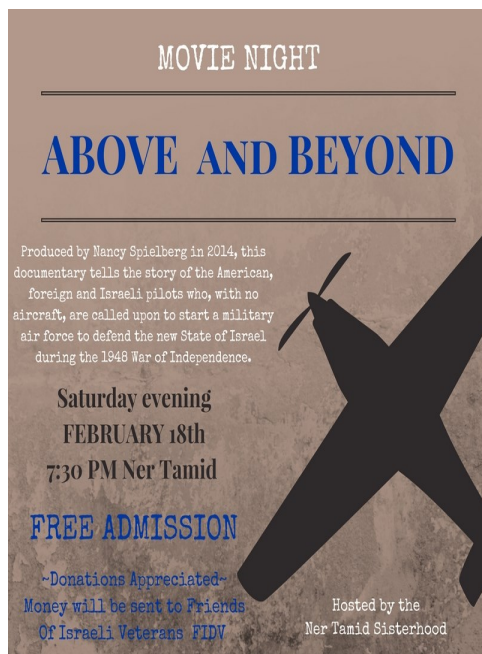

In this week's Parsha, the Jewish People are told that they should take the blood of the Korban Pesach/ Pascal Lamb and smear it on their doorposts. The Torah says this was done so Hashem would see it and jump over their homes and not kill the Jewish firstborns.

Does Hashem need a sign on the door? Can't Hashem see through the house?!
Why then did they need to put the blood on the doors?
