Ian Buruma's grandparents were prosperous English Jews who were very English in the way that their family in Germany were very German. The book addresses the problems of being Jewish, cultural assimilation and anti-Semitism. They were able to rescue 12 Jewish children from the Nazis and support them in England. Buruma uses the thousands of letters his grandparents wrote to each other during their separation through 2 world wars to construct the story.
